

he Department of Conservation (DOC) is considering options to reinstate walking access to Cathedral Cove. The track was closed in February 2023 after several slips. A short-term fix could see construction of new steps and boardwalk to reinstate a section of the existing track. One of the long-term options could see the installation of a new cantilevered staircase and steps to the beach, but is likely to require significant investment. Other options include reinstating the Hahei short walk, stabilisation of the current Grange Road entrance and looking at a short-term walk over private farmland.
