Pink Ribbon events this month

Two Pink Ribbon events are happening this month, one in Tairua on May 24th, and one in Pauanui on May 22nd, to raise awareness and funds for Breast Cancer Foundation NZ.

In Tairua, local Ann Paget, is keen to encourage women to be attentive to regular breast checks, with good reason. A breast cancer survivor, she was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2020, at the age of 67. Early detection resulted in Ann having a lumpectomy followed by radiation treatment.

Ann will be hosting a Pink Ribbon event at her home, as "a nice social way for women of

different ages to get together and raise money for a needy cause." An evening event, Ann's do is on Friday 24 May from 4-6pm and will involve pink beverages, nibbles, quizzes and games. If you are interested in attending contact her at: annrolphsmith@gmail.com.

The Department of Conservation (DOC) is considering options to reinstate walking access to Cathedral Cove. The track was closed in February 2023 after several slips. A short-term fix could see construction of new steps and boardwalk to reinstate a section of the existing track. One of the long-term options could see the installation of a new cantilevered staircase and steps to the beach, but is likely to require significant investment. Other options include reinstating the Hahei short walk, stabilisation of the current Grange Road entrance and looking at a short-term walk over private farmland.

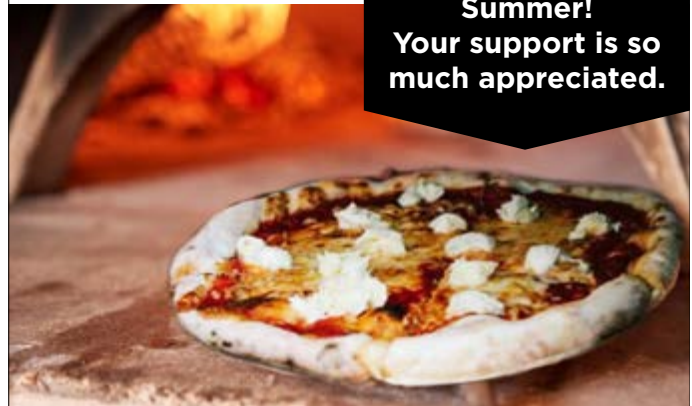
