#### A round up from Tairua Fire Brigade, coming events



Tairua Volunteer Fire Brigade is looking forward to their annual Firefighters' Easter Market, on Saturday 19 April from 9am - 1pm at Tairua Fire Station. And so am I! The Market will feature their famous mussel fritters and sausage sizzle! For those who can see past their tummies, there will be raffles with some wonderful local prizes and vouchers, and an array of stalls including several new ones. All proceeds from the Market will be going to muchneeded equipment upgrades. Make sure you go along to support this Market. Go early if you are a mussel fritter fan! As most of you will be aware,

all of our emergency services have had a busy summer season. The Fire Brigade responded to 21 call outs. To help spread the load and build resilience, the Brigade is looking for more recruits. Anyone interested is welcome to attend a training session at the Station on a Tuesday night from 7pm to see what they do.

This year a group of four Brigade Volunteers is taking part in the Firefighters Skytower Challenge. The Skytower Challenge requires the participants to climb Auckland's 328m Skytower in full kit to raise money for Leukaemia & Blood Cancer New Zealand. This year Josh

To keep your fireplace in good condition and ensure it is burning as efficiently as it should, use



dry, seasoned firewood and maintain a proper airflow.

In the spirit of camaraderie Tairua Brigade would like to extend its congratulations and thanks to Fred Crawford of the Pauanui Brigade who recently received his Double Gold Star medal for long service in Fire & Emergency.

Enquires have been ongoing in relation to an Arson at the Pepe Ridge Development where retaining wall poles were set alight. A home-made explosive was also found at the site believed to be connected to the same incident. We are following lines of enquiry but would also encourage those with information to call Crime Stoppers 0800 555 111 and quote Police File 250318/0722.

The Speed Shop in Tairua township was subject to an overnight burglary where a car jack was stolen. Thankfully with great quality cameras and community networking, through social media, a suspect has been nominated. The tip off has been given to Coromandel Police for follow up, the vehicle involved is also sought in relation to other offending from around the Peninsula.
